FOREWORD

The current issue of the journal «Researches in Religious Studies», first of 2015, is dedicated to New Religious Movements. Here we have papers addressing such diverse problems as Russian paganism influencing ergonyms (Andrey Beskov), the cult of Santa Muerte in Mexico and the USA (Anton Dannenberg), the contemporary reconstructions of Ancient Egyptian religion (Artem Tyurin), creeds of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter–Day Saints (Sergey Saltanov).
